

# REIMBURSEMENT SCHEDULE 2016-2017

The following reimbursement schedule is for all sports presently participating in sectional, regional or state championship competition. This reimbursement schedule has been updated and approved by the Board of Directors.

It is interesting to note that West Virginia is one of the few state associations to provide a reimbursement program covering non-revenue producing as well as revenue producing sports. Most states have been forced into either a non-funding scheme of covering non-revenue producing sports or causing each school to provide an entry fee for each individual participant in a state sponsored activity.

Approximately 54 percent of all tournament receipts are expended for necessary game expenses. This includes game management, officials, facility, awards, and reimbursement. The remainder of these receipts are expended for publications, insurance, National Federation Rule Books, clinics, and other services.

We hope each school and those persons responsible for athletic finances will find this information useful when making financial decisions related to tournament or playoff competition in the upcoming school year. **All reimbursement will end according to the date and time of your schools elimination from state sponsored tournaments.**

## Hotel / Motel Policy

Effective with the 2010-2011 school year, member schools that are eligible to receive reimbursement for lodging at state championship sites **MUST** be housed at hotel/motel sites that participate in a cooperative agreement with the WVS-SAC. *(Member schools will be notified by information posted on the WVS-SAC website and material included in the sport specific coaches packets as to which lodging sites have entered into an agreement with the WVSSAC.)*

*Schools that choose to use unapproved lodging sites will not receive any reimbursement.*
