The said official agrees to be present and officiate the game(s) listed as follows:

- A. Official must be agreed upon by all schools involved in this contest.
- B. This contract shall be returned to the originating school/tournament director within ten (10) days from date listed on contract. Otherwise, contract will be considered null and void.
- C. If the event is cancelled by reason mutually agreed upon by the schools/tournament director, then the following shall apply:
 - If the official is notified in time to prevent travel to the site of the event, there shall be no payment to the official, provided the official is offered the opportunity to officiate the postponed event on the new date.
 - If the official is notified in time to prevent travel to the site of the event, and the official is not offered the opportunity to officiate the postponed event on the new date, the official shall be paid the contract price less travel expense.
 - If the official is not notified in time to prevent travel to the site of the event, and the official is offered the opportunity to officiate the postponed event on the new date, the official shall be paid travel and meal expenses.
 - If the official is not notified in time to prevent travel to the site of the event, and the official is not offered the opportunity to officiate the postponed event on the new date, the official shall be paid the full contract price including travel expenses.
- D. Mileage shall be paid only upon the single rate if the officials travel to the site in the same car.
- E. The official agrees to arrive in advance of scheduled contest time for pre-game conference, etc. in accordance with NFHS and WVSSAC rules.
- F. Services provided by the official are as an independent contractor.
- G. The official assumes all liability for injury to him/herself and waives any claim for an injury, loss or damage which may be sustained by the official during any game, contest or activity against the schools involved or West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.
- H. It is understood that the services of the official are provided as an independent contractor and that no medical insurance, workers compensation, unemployment insurance or other benefit is accorded to the official by this contract.
- I. This contract is considered binding by both parties and cannot be negated except through mutual agreement of the parties.

If either party hereto fails to fulfill the obligation of any part of this contract, that party shall pay to the offended party the amount specified above as the fee for the event, the remainder of the contract shall not be binding and the breach of contract shall be reported to the Executive Director of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.
