

## GOLF

### **Regional Tournament**

**(Please refer to the August Interscholastic for current Golf Tournament Guidelines.)**

1. The Board of Directors will be responsible for the selection of site, time, date (Week 13) and tournament directors.
2. There are no restrictions on practice play or interscholastic matches on the regional site.
3. Teams or individuals who are entering for medalist honors only must have participated in 6 regular season matches on 6 different days to qualify for regional play.
4. There may be 3 or 4 players on a team with the aggregate score of the low three team members counted.
5. Coaches must hand a list of players to the director one half hour before the starting time.
6. Teams shall be advised that they are guests of the club and shall conduct themselves accordingly.
7. **Director's Responsibilities**
  - a. You are acting as the WVSSAC representative; therefore, please see that all rules and regulations are followed.
  - b. Make sure that the golf course is properly marked for hazards and out-of-bounds (Check with the club pro).
  - c. Familiarize yourself with the local rules.
  - d. Check the following in the prematch meeting:
    - 1) Discuss local rules.
    - 2) Smoking or the use of tobacco products on the course or near the clubhouse is not permitted. Violation will result in disqualification.
    - 3) No use of caddies or carts (unless approved by the Executive Director).
    - 4) Proper tournament dress.
    - 5) Pairings shall be threesomes or foursomes.
    - 6) The head coach may coach the entire course except for putting greens and sand bunkers.
    - 7) Must have a coach/faculty representative with team.
    - 8) Arrange for an adult scorer to accompany each group.
    - 9) Discuss procedure for reporting scores and signing score cards at the completion of play.

- 10) In the event of a tie for first and second place, the fourth golfers score on each team will be added to the team total score as the first tie breaker. Any teams tied for low score after the first tie breaker shall play off via the "sudden death" method.
  - 11) Each regional shall qualify two teams per class and the top two (2) individual golfers not on the winning teams to the state tournament.
  - 12) Participants violating the above rules will be disqualified and may cause team disqualification.
- e. At the conclusion of the match you will:
- 1) Complete the report form and send to the WVSSAC office as soon as possible (Form G1).
  - 2) Fax a copy of Form G1 to Scott Davidson (304-295-7336) immediately after the regional match.
  - 3) Present the regional team plaques.
    - 1) Compile the results to determine winners.
    - 2) Present the awards furnished by the WVSSAC office.
    - 3) Send results to the WVSSAC office and to Scott Davidson.
